Online Safety for 3-5 Year Olds – Parent Meeting
Monday 27th April 2026

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to invite you to attend a meeting at school which will have a focus of *Online Safety for Children aged 3-5*. The meeting will take place in the school hall on **Monday 27th April at 8:50 – 9:20 am**.

The session will be led by Terry Franke, who is an E-Safeguarding Specialist from Salford Children's Services. I cannot recommend Terry's sessions enough to parents; he is an expert in the field of online safety, and I can guarantee you that you will leave the session with a strong picture of how to protect your child in a digital sense in 2026. Many parents have attended a previous whole-school meeting, led by Terry, in January 2026. Their feedback was overwhelmingly positive as the session was so useful.

This session has a specific focus of online safety for pupils in nursery and reception aged classes. Terry will be working with pupils in these classes following the parental session where he will build upon the existing e-safety teaching which has already taken place in class this academic year. One element of the meeting will focus upon screen time for children aged 3-5. You may have already noted recent news reports which highlight government guidance around screen time for this age group: [Screen time for under-fives should be limited to one hour a day, parents told - BBC News](#). Terry will discuss this content and offer advice around this area at the meeting.

I cannot recommend attending the meeting enough. I can guarantee that you will find the session informative and find ways to help protect and guide your child in a 'digital sense'.
